Tony winner puts up estate for \$2.5 million

KENT — Esteemed Broadway director, producer and choreographer Robert Avian this week listed his massive estate at 346 Kent Cornwall Road with William Pitt Sotheby's International Realty. The asking price is \$2.5 million for 105 acres, but for the full 252 acres, the price rises to \$3.62 million.

About 40 years ago, the multiple Tony Award winner purchased the property that originally was constructed as a guest lodge. The rustic lodge feel was preserved in the post-and-beam great room, which features high ceilings and a stone fireplace, as well as the living room, and dining and gaming areas. The four-bedroom main house also has a kitchen with an original beehive oven, and a second great room on the upper floor with views over Flanders Mountain.


