Highest Priced Property in Westchester County Comes to Market with Julia B. Fee Sotheby's International Realty

David Fenton, founder and CEO of Twin Oaks Construction, said that he and partner Steve Oder will expand the home's original 8.400 square feet to about 21.000.

"Upon completion this rare and magnificent estate will be an incomparable residence of luxury, comfort and stature," said Fenton. Noting that the property is sited on a ridge surrounded by pastoral vistas, he added, "With breathtaking and unparalleled views of the Hudson Valley, this spectacular home will also feature the ultimate in the most sought-

Introduced by a long, winding drive, the completed home will have nine bedrooms, eight full and four half baths, and a ballroom, with interior living spaces highlighted by artisanal craftsmanship, high ceilings and fine millwork. Outside, the property will include a motor court and fountain, 11,000 square feet of patios and terraces, infinity pool with waterfall and spa, fully equipped outdoor kitchen, two tennis courts, basketball court, stone gazebo with Hudson Valley views, and formal English gardens with a maze.

"This one of a kind architectural masterpiece is equally perfect for quiet living and entertaining guests on a grand scale," said Knief. "A buying opportunity like this, less than one hour from Manhattan, really only comes along once in a lifetime.


