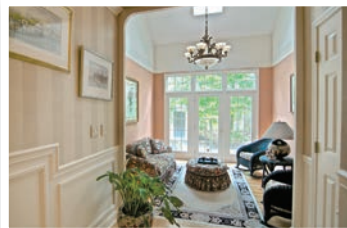
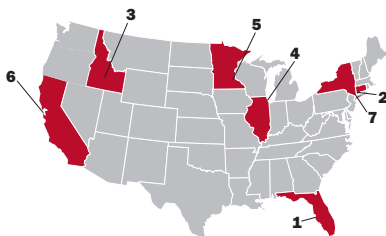


This week: Parkside homes



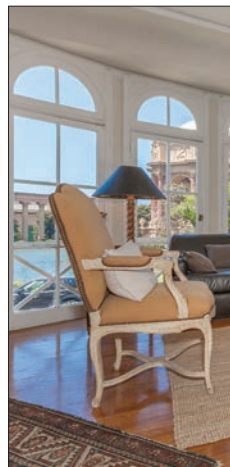
