A half-timbered style, which entails a mixture of wood framing and stone, as well as five chimneys grace the residence's exterior with a distinct Tudor design.

The home's distinguishing interior feature is its great room, which boasts a 16-foot ceiling and carved stone fireplace, designed after a medieval great hall. The house also has a formal dining room with windows overlooking the garden, a large eat-in kitchen with carved wood panels, as well as a lower level complete with a wine cellar, family room and fitness room. The residence contains five bedrooms and four baths.
