Connecticut River Run Compound!

Many homes come with water features and postcard settings, but few can match this 1950's New England estate surrounded by mature pine and birch trees and cascading waterfalls in the backyard. On the banks of the Aspetuck River in Westport, Connecticut, the estate includes an 11,000-square-foot mansion with stone terraces that overlook the water and stone steps that meander down to the river and a classic stone lodge hugging the river - surrounded by more stone walls and two private bridges.

Built in 1955, the compound sets on 2.75 acres and includes seven bedrooms, ten bathrooms, a tennis court, guest cottage, greenhouse, twelve-car garage, indoor and outdoor pools, four fireplaces, a spiral staircase, detailed woodwork, tile and wood floors, a generator and a bar room. The main house is filled with cheerful sunlight from banks of French doors and windows.

Westport is one of America's wealthiest towns, a commuting town to New York City with a history that goes back to the Revolutionary War in 1777 when British soldiers were trapped at Compo Beach by the Continental Army. It was the fictional home for Darrin and Samantha in the 1960's TV show *Bewitched* and the real life home of Paul Newman.
