This rather nice whitewashed, curvaceous Bauhaus <http://curbed.com/tags/bauhaus> home, built circa 1938, is the work of architect Arthur Holden, a lesser-known designer who friend of both Frank Lloyd Wright <http://curbed.com/frank-lloyd-wright> and the academic Lewis Mumford <http://curbed.com/tags/lewismumford> . The house's curved walls were meant to take advantage of its five-and-a-half acre hilltop site, where natural light and lush surroundings. Inside the 4-

bedroom, 1-bath house (which clocks in at **4,035 square feet**). Some of the interior finishes, like floors of slate and terrazzo, may not be everyone's *jam* per se, but they do give the interiors a certain shade of era authenticity.
