Her paintings can be found in collections throughout New York, New Jersey, Connecticut, South Carolina, Michigan and Florida. Goodfellow currently teaches classes in landscape and abstract painting at the Rowayton Arts Center.

During the September 13th "Sundays at Sotheby's" artist reception, the Rowayton office will welcome some of Goodfellow's latest paintings to its walls. Wine and *hors d'oeuvres* will be served in a casual setting with opportunities to talk with Goodfellow, and discuss her work. All events of the evening are open to the public.
