The Fairfield home was owned by Wilson, but Coward utilized it as his Connecticut retreat when in New York, eventually purchasing the adjoining lot, where a pool and pool house were built. Both Coward and Wilson entertained many international theater and film stars while here, with one particularly special party welcoming "Gone with the Wind" actress Vivian Leigh, Lawrence Olivier and George Brent as their guests.

Constructed in 1927 by noted New York architect and Anglophile Francis Hamilton, the brick house, with its asymmetrical massing, boasts Paladian dormer windows, Tudor chimney pots and a hooded entry inspired by English architecture. After extensively traveling abroad, Hamilton brought skilled European craftsmen to the site to create and install Norwegian pine paneling, wood moldings, hand-carved wood garlands and marble fireplace surrounds in various spaces including the home's spacious living room. Also known as the "drawing room," this area offers 10-foot ceilings and tall casement bay windows that embrace the property's surrounding views of Long Island Sound and Southport Harbor. A library, paneled dining room and family room with fireplace, as well as an updated kitchen and breakfast room, offer open, light filled spaces with a comfortable, updated design plan for modern living and casual entertaining. The residence's stately interior also includes seven bedrooms, all with en suite baths, as well as three half baths.

"This home is a true testament to the talent, lifestyle and influences of these prominent individuals," said Fingelly. "Coward enjoyed designing and collecting, which can be seen in various elements throughout the residence including the foyer, where he added antique twin mirrors with theatrical faces over wall-mounted demi-lune tables.
