

NEW TO THE MARKET IS A \$3.8 MILLION LISTING ON Bantam Lake in Litchfield County, the state's largest natural lake. Architect Drexel Yeager designed the home for former Porsche racecar driver David Geremia with tons of fun toys, including an outdoor kitchen and fireplace, a massive deck with a hot tub and a lower level featuring a two-tiered movie theater, a wine tasting room, a sauna, a steam room and a gym. Water views fill nearly every window in the house but are especially exhilarating from the two master suites, one each on the first and second floors. Another great lakeside listing is called Stony Brook Farm in Bridgewater. On 28 acres, the spread offers a little bit of everything New England is famous for. A FOUR-ACRE PROPERTY IN NEW CANAAN HAS BEEN FEATURED ON GARDEN TOURS, thanks to its bountiful specimen trees, ornamental boxwood and other plantings. The gated drive leads to a stately gardened courtyard, while the entire back of the house is graced with landscaped stone terraces. Designed by architects Gardiner & Larson Homes in 1998, the 13,526-square-foot interiors were entirely renovated five years ago. We love the gracious entry hall with its dramatic staircase and picture gallery but would happily spend time on the lower level with its stone hearth adjacent to a full bar, walk-in wine cellar and Equinox-like fitness room.
