# MAKING AN **ENTRANCE**

Nothing beats a great first impression, as lyna Bort Caruso discovers.

Fine design is about the creation of memorable spaces, and a home's entrance represents the one shot architects have to make the right impression. "An entrance is the starting point from which everything begins to unfold," says Chris Whitehead, managing director of Gulf Sotheby's International Realty in Dubai. "It dictates the way the property talks to visitors," he adds. "The feeling generated in the entrance echoes throughout the house."

To visitors, entrance halls are where a home's character is first encountered. They can exude boldness, calm, a regard for history, a concern for warm hospitality or a penchant for drama - among other things. Their moodaltering capacity creates a sense of anticipation about the entire property. "When someone walks into an entry space that is inspirational, [that] has great proportion and incorporates beautiful materials, those are the elements you savour," says Nancy Ruddy, cofounder and managing principal of the architectural firm CetraRuddy in New York, a 2015 inductee into the Interior Design Hall of Fame.


Today's entrances differ from the soaring ceilings, expensive consoles and large flower arrangements of old. Contemporary foyers are warmer and more nurturing, with a greater interplay of natural materials like stone and wood. Art is more prominent, too. The entrance to one of Whitehead's listings, for instance, features sculptures set in an infinity reflecting pool. For her part, Ruddy frequently incorporates her clients' artworks into their entryways, which provide the ideal environment for showcasing art collections and the owners' tastes. Homewners appreciate this approach: "As one client told us, 'I never tire of coming into my home. There's something amazing when you open the door." Now, that's an inspirational




# **MONETA**
