The home was built in 1963 by the owner's uncle for her grandparents.

The home incorporates every detail you could ever ask for, including master-sized rooms and a butler's staircase. The home has beautiful red oak floors throughout the main and upper levels.

A bright, spacious entry is the perfect invite to the home. A mild yellow palette with pristine white trim and an oak hardwood floor presents a classic ambiance.

A large closet is conveniently located off to the side. The white trim and soft palette continues seamlessly into the formal living room where a brick wood-burning fireplace with a country white mantel creates a sense of warmth and comfort. A large, custom-designed, eatin kitchen is well-appointed with ample cabinetry, a rustic Pottery Barn all-wood center island, granite countertops, travertine tile, recessed lighting and a tiled floor. High-end stainless steel appliances include a dishwasher, a refrigerator and a double wall oven. The owner noted the kitchen offers plenty of work space for food preparation. Sliders open to a rear deck.

Peace and quiet is found in the library. Numerous wood built-ins and shelving was designed and constructed by the owner's husband to provide plenty of space for books and reference materials. The room has two large windows that bring in natural light.

A regal dining room is awash in a convivial palette complemented by white panel molding, white trim and pillars. Large windows with custom treatments look out on the vard and fill the

room with sunshine.

"It's an elegant room with lots of colonial color. The light royal blue walls pop above the crisp white chair rail/wainscoting." said Gifford.

The den is affectionately called the 'saloon' by the owner because it has a western theme.

"Prior to listing the house, we had many pictures of Ronnie Van Zant and our friends from Lynyrd Skynyrd and other country musicians," confided the owner.

Two wood staircases, one with a balcony overlooking the foyer, offers access to the upper level and an exquisite master bedroom suite. The expansive room embraces you in luxury with its exceptional details, including a dressing room with a glass front, a walk-in his-and-her closet, a small sitting room, a vaulted tray ceiling, a green palette, white trim, recessed lighting and plenty of windows.

"Enjoy peace and solitude in the brand new master bathroom that was specially designed in 2016 with luxurious decor and details," said Gifford. You'll appreciate the double vanity with granite countertops, a jetted tub and a separate shower with seamless shower doors and custom tile design. The room has an entire wall of closets built by Ken Frey and trimmed out with the same trim used to complete journalist/newscaster Paula Zahn's home.

Three additional bedrooms with recessed lighting are located on the upper level. Two have red oak hardwood floors; one has wall-to-wall carpeting.

Additional amenities include an upper level laundry room, a security system, a central vacuum, an attic with pull-down stairs, a half-finished basement used as a game room and a two-car garage with direct access to the basement. A new furnace was recently installed.
