He is a permanent member of the American Society of Marine Artists, and has been the subject of a one-man show and numerous group shows at prestigious galleries throughout the U.S. and abroad. Skalamera currently resides and works in Fort Lee, N.I.

All paintings exhibited during the "Sunday's at Sotheby's" event will remain on display throughout the entire month. Skalamera is set to serve as the featured artist of the 55th annual CCNS Art Show & Sale, a popular community event offering one of the largest and most diverse collections of original artwork in the state of Connecticut.

The show's opening night gala will be held on June 1 with additional dates on June 2 and 3 at the Workshop of Black Bridge Motors, located at 314 Wilson Ave., South Norwalk.
