living and dining rooms.

Despite its in-town location this townhouse offers exceptional privacy while also providing easy access to every town amenity. The individual, couple, or family that chooses this townhouse as their next home could live a European lifestyle if they want to. Walk or bike everywhere in minutes. This house is within easy walking distance to local schools, the YMCA, and Waveny Park in one direction, as well as to the town center with its shops and restaurants, the public library, and the Metro North train station in the other direction. Also nearby are Mead Memorial Park which has tennis courts, and the Bristow Bird Sanctuary on Old Stamford Road which has wooded walking trails.

For those who do have a vehicle or two, this property is not far from the Merritt Parkway, and it has an attached, over-sized two-car

garage as well as a driveway with off-street parking for two more vehicles.

Although this 3.850square-foot house was built in 1977 it does not show its "age." The renovated home looks like it was constructed in the modern era. French doors topped with an arched transom open to the foyer, where the staircase has a decorative skirt board and balusters. The house features four bedrooms, a designer kitchen; a fireplace, hardwood floors painted black, and a lower level with flexible use space. The lower level has two rooms with wall-to-wall carpeting, one of which could serve as a family, game, play or media room. The other could be an office or exercise room. There is also an en suite guest bedroom with a marble bath, and a large walk-in cedar closet with organizers on this level.

On the main living level there is a media room or office to the left of the fover that has built-in bookshelves and cabinetry. To the right is the kitchen, which features marble counters, a breakfast bar for five, double wall ovens, a Sub-Zero refrigerator, and a white ceramic subway tile backsplash above the five-burner Bosch range top. The fireplace is in the formal living room, and there is wainscoting on the lower walls of the dining room.

On the second floor the master suite has egg and dart crown molding, a walk-in closet, and a marble bath with a double vanity. Two other bedrooms share a hall bath.

The garage has storage space in the vehicle bay area as well as a separate storage room that is quite large.
