Built in 1981, the more than 3,200square-foot home is located on 1.84 acres at 33 Tanglewood Drive on Danbury's westside.

As you step through the freshlyvarnished wood and glass door and into a graceful fover, you will feel instantly embraced by the home's infinite warmth. This space has a heated tiled floor and a convenient

Some of its outstanding details include high-end cabinetry, granite countertops, a center island with an abundance of storage drawers, a generously-sized pantry, recessed lighting and ceramic tile flooring with radiant heat. Stainless steel appliances include a double oven, a refrigerator, a gas cooktop stove and a microwave. A casual dining area is located nearby. Glass sliders open to a rear wood deck.

"It's perfect for barbecues and social gatherings," said Lewis.

A gorgeous three season sunroom is sited directly off the kitchen. This bright, spacious room is detailed with wood floors, a paddle fan and windows and screens on all sides.

"This room is great for those hot summer evenings," Lewis said. The sunroom offers panoramic views of the property. A door opens onto a wood deck where you can enjoy more up-close-and-personal views of nature.

"The living room is a bright room with with plenty of windows combining a casual style and elegance," Lewis said.

In addition, the main level has a bonus room that features wall-towall carpeting and heated flooring. It offers many uses.

An updated powder room with a heated ceramic tile floor completes the main level.

This spacious room has soothing light beige walls, raised panel doors, white woodwork and windows that bask the room in sunlight. Also, it has a double closet and a full master bathroom with ceramic tile floor and a glass enclosed tile shower stall.

Also, there are three additional bedrooms; the third bedroom is located near the master bedroom suite and can be used as a nursery, if needed, or as part of the master bedroom suite. This bedroom has a double closet. Servicing these bedrooms is a full bathroom with a BainUltra jet tub, double sinks and a tile floor and countertops.

"It's a front-to-back finished room with two closets and wall-to-wall carpeting," said Lewis, noting it offers numerous possibilities and can serve a variety of purposes, such as an exercise room or a play room.

Additional amenities include central air conditioning, an oversized two-car garage, a whole house fan, and a furnace room and work space.

The home's brick and vinyl siding give this colonial a classic New England feel. The property, set back from the road with steps leading to the front porch, is impeccable.

"The landscaping is exceptional. Brick and stone walls and walkways, and the professional plantings complete the outside," said Lewis, adding it's the most tranquil and private home where you can just enjoy being outdoors on the wood deck or relaxing in the vard on a warm summer day.
