Separated by white pillars, the dining room is an elegant space featuring a tray ceiling and white panel molding.

"The pillars are a finishing touch that make the room open yet provide a private space for entertaining purposes," she said.

A large window keeps the room bright and sunny. The dining room leads into a generously-sized living room. Comfortable and beautifully designed, the room has a gas fireplace, hardwood floors, white panel molding and a soft color palette in addition to two large windows and recessed lighting. A half bathroom with a pedestal sink completes the main level.

Additional amenities include an oversized laundry room with a tiled floor and cabinetry, central air conditioning, an attic, a spacious two-car attached garage and a full, unfinished basement.

For outdoor relaxation or entertaining, the townhome has a deck that overlooks the property.
