'Comfortable living' at waterfront home in Shippan Point

If you are looking for a custom designed, truly one-of-a-kind direct waterfront home with privacy and relaxed living, then look no further than this gem on Ocean View Drive in the St. David Bluff's Association.

"This home reflects comfortable living and a feel-good sense of being at peace with the sea and the sandy beach," said June Rosenthal, William Pitt Sotheby's International Realty's co-listing agent, along with Linda Sentementes.

The 32-year-old 5,032-squarefoot gem, Rosenthal said, "has an extraordinary and intriguing high, wide and handsome open interior with extensive views of water everywhere."

While water is one of the biggest assets and attractions, Rosenthal noted that while the home is close to the beach, it's not in a flood zone.

The home has a spacious lower level walkout with an impressive family room of window walls and a floor-to-ceiling stone fireplace. The lower level, Rosenthal said, is ready to impress with a wine closet, an office/bedroom/bath, storage and an exercise studio with glass doors leading to the ground level patio that abuts the beach.

The home — which has three bedrooms, four bathrooms and eight rooms in total — also has a curved window-walled living room "with a spectacular glass ceiling and fossil shell tile floors," Rosenthal said.

Rosenthal added: "Stand behind the kitchen sink and marvel as everything opens to the two-story living room and dining areas to synchronize those captivating views."

There is also a soaring 34-foot stone fireplace, a powder room and a terrace off the dining room.

"The whole house is a powerful expanse of space and light," Rosenthal said.

Then, there is the upstairs master suite with a luxurious master bath.

"(It is a) very special master bedroom with its own terrace and large glass wall to take in the water views from that second story level," she
