

"SO SWEET"



Directly on the water is the private dock with a path that leads to the capacious back decks and balconies, including the second-floor balcony attached to the main bedroom suite. The main floor boasts a kitchen with a fireplace and open-plan living and family spaces, all with access to a wall comprising three sets of French doors. 
"A CAR-COLLECTOR'S DREAM"
