After college, Tina began her career with a variety of jobs in the arts, starting as a receptionist for a German magazine in their New York office, moving on to working as a catalogue photographer's assistant and then freelancing for many photographers in the food business, allowing her opportunities to travel back to Europe and other parts of the world. By the time she was 28 years old, she had put together her own portfolio and decided to immerse herself into the food photography world. "A year later, I went out on my own. My first paid job was for Food & Wine Magazine. They selected one of my photos as their cover! I never needed to look for work again in the photography business." Tina starting shooting for magazines and national brands such as Weight Watchers, Chipolte, Martha Stewart, the New York Times, Bon Appetit, to name a few. She was the feature photographer for Everyday with Rachel Ray magazine for years as well as her cookbooks. She photographed cookbooks for celebrities such as Oprah, Mario Batali, and Giada DeLaurentis. Her career skyrocketed. She met and married her husband, also a photographer, and they settled in New York City where their first daughter was born.

"We purchased a weekend home in Old Saybrook in 2007. I have always lived by the shore and loved the antique homes of New England. Old Saybrook was the perfect choice and an ideal location because it was just 2 hours from New York. Plus, as a foodie, it has many great restaurants in the area!"
